(A) IN THIS SUBTITLE THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.

(B) "BOARD" MEANS THE MARYLAND WINEGROWERS' WINERY AND GRAPE GROWERS' ADVISORY BOARD.

(C) "ENOLOGY" MEANS THOSE PRACTICES AND BODIES OF KNOWLEDGE THAT ARE INVOLVED IN THE PRODUCING, AGING, STORING, AND PACKAGING OF WINE.

(D) "GRAPE GROWER" MEANS A PERSON WHO:

(1) GROWS GRAPES FOR COMMERCIAL PURPOSES; AND

(2) (I) SELLS AT LEAST \$10,000 WORTH OF GRAPES EACH YEAR; OR

(II) HAS PLANTED AT LEAST 3 ACRES OF VINES OF A TYPE USED FOR THE PRODUCTION OF WINE.

(E) "SECRETARY" MEANS THE SECRETARY OF AGRICULTURE OR A DESIGNEE OF THE SECRETARY.

(F) "VITICULTURE" MEANS THE CULTIVATION AND STUDY OF GRAPES AND GRAPE VINES.

(G) "WINE" HAS THE MEANING STATED IN ARTICLE 2B, § 2 OF THE CODE.

(H) ~~"WINEGROWER" MEANS A PERSON WHO PRODUCES WINE FROM APPROVED PRODUCTS GROWN BY THE PERSON.~~

(I) "WINERY" MEANS AN ESTABLISHMENT THAT HAS A WINERY LICENSE OR LIMITED WINERY LICENSE UNDER ARTICLE 2B, § 5 OF THE CODE.
