

(B) THE MANNER OF ELECTION OF OFFICERS SHALL BE AS THE BOARD DETERMINES.

(A) A MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS THEN SERVING ON THE BOARD IS A QUORUM.

(B) THE BOARD SHALL DETERMINE THE TIMES AND PLACES OF ITS REGULAR AND SPECIAL MEETINGS.

(C) THE CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD:

(1) MAY CALL A SPECIAL MEETING AT ANY TIME; AND

(2) SHALL CALL A SPECIAL MEETING WHEN REQUESTED BY 2 OR MORE MEMBERS OF THE BOARD.

(D) A MEMBER OF THE BOARD:

(1) MAY NOT RECEIVE COMPENSATION; BUT

(2) IS ENTITLED TO REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES UNDER THE STANDARD STATE TRAVEL REGULATIONS, AS PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET.

(E) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PROVIDE STAFF SERVICES AND SUPPORT FOR THE BOARD.
