

(iv) Limit a driver's time or hours on duty or require a driver to maintain a record of duty status if:

1. The driver operates only within a 100 air mile radius of the driver's normal work reporting location; and

2. The driver returns to the driver's normal reporting location and is released from work within a period of 15 consecutive hours;

(v) Apply the provisions of Parts 391 and 395 of the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Regulations to a farmer, or an agent or employee of a farmer, who operates farm equipment or a motor vehicle owned or operated by the farmer in the transportation of supplies to a farm or the transportation of farm products as defined in § 10-601 of the agriculture article; or

(vi) Apply the medical examination and certification requirements of Sections 391.43 and 391.45 of the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Regulations to a driver who operates routinely within a 100 air mile radius of the driver's normal work reporting location.

(2) Nothing contained in this subsection limits regulation of the qualifications or hours of service of a driver of a vehicle:

(i) In interstate commerce; or

(ii) Transporting hazardous materials.
