

(3) 2 REPRESENTATIVES OF GOVERNMENT.

(B) (1) THE TERM OF A MEMBER IS 3 YEARS.

(2) THE TERMS OF MEMBERS ARE STAGGERED AS REQUIRED BY THE TERMS PROVIDED FOR MEMBERS OF THE BOARD ON JULY 1, 1987.

(3) AT THE END OF A TERM, A MEMBER CONTINUES TO SERVE UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES.

(4) A MEMBER WHO IS APPOINTED AFTER A TERM HAS BEGUN SERVES ONLY FOR THE REST OF THE TERM AND UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES.

(C) THE MEMBERS OF THE BOARD SHALL SERVE WITHOUT COMPENSATION, BUT SHALL BE REIMBURSED FOR ALL REASONABLE EXPENSES INCURRED IN THE PERFORMANCE OF THEIR DUTIES.

~~(D) THE BOARD SHALL ANNUALLY ELECT A CHAIRMAN FROM ITS MEMBERS AND APPOINT A SECRETARY.~~

~~(E) EACH MEMBER OF THE BOARD SHALL FILE A FINANCIAL DISCLOSURE STATEMENT IN ACCORDANCE WITH §§ 4-101 AND 4-103 OF ARTICLE 40A.~~

(F) (D) BY JANUARY 1 OF EACH YEAR, THE BOARD SHALL FILE AN ANNUAL REPORT ON ITS ACTIVITIES TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 2-1312 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE.

(A) THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN RESOURCES IN CONSULTATION WITH THE BOARD SHALL:

(1) DEVELOP THE PROGRAM IN COLLABORATION WITH STATE PROGRAMS CURRENTLY SERVING DISABLED INDIVIDUALS AND WITH COMMUNITY AGENCIES OR OTHER ORGANIZATIONS THAT HAVE ESTABLISHED RELAY PROGRAMS;

(2) IMPLEMENT THE PROGRAM THROUGHOUT THE STATE WITHIN 2 YEARS FROM THE CREATION OF THE BOARD;

~~(3) PROVIDE FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE AND OTHER ASSISTANCE FOR THE OPERATION OF THE PROGRAM BY ANY MEANS THE BOARD FINDS APPROPRIATE; AND~~

(4) (3) MAINTAIN AN INFORMATION AND REFERRAL SERVICE TO PROVIDE INFORMATION ABOUT THE AVAILABILITY OF THE RELAY SERVICE.
