~~(A) THE PROGRAM SHALL BE FUNDED BY MONEYS CONTRIBUTED DIRECTLY TO THE PROGRAM BY TELEPHONE COMPANIES. THE PROGRAM SHALL BE FUNDED AS PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET.~~

~~(B) A TELEPHONE COMPANY THAT HAS CONTRIBUTED MONEY TO FUND THE PROGRAM MAY DEDUCT THE SUM CONTRIBUTED FROM THE TELEPHONE COMPANY'S ANNUAL GROSS RECEIPTS TAX DUE UNDER § 130 OF ARTICLE 81 OF THE CODE.~~

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the terms of the initial members of the Telecommunications for Disabled Individuals Board shall expire as determined by lot, as follows:

- (1) -5- 3 members in 1988;
- (2) -5- 3 members in 1989;
- (3) -5- 3 members in 1990; and
- (4) -4- 2 members in 1991.
