

Board of County Commissioners of St. Mary's County, containing a detailed statement of the nature of the receipts and manner of expenditures, the number of licenses issued, the number of examinations given, and the percentage who passed of those taking the examination.

B. In addition, the report shall include a budget request to meet the expenses of the Board for the ensuing year.]

38-16.

A. THE BOARD SHALL SUBMIT AN ANNUAL REPORT TO THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, BEFORE THE SECOND MONDAY OF JULY OF EACH YEAR, CONTAINING A DETAILED STATEMENT OF THE NUMBER OF LICENSES ISSUED, THE NUMBER OF EXAMINATIONS GIVEN, AND THE PERCENTAGE OF THOSE PASSING THE EXAMINATION.

B. THE BOARD SHALL SUBMIT MONTHLY MINUTES OF REGULAR BOARD MEETINGS TO THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS.

38-21.

A. A PERSON, FIRM, OR CORPORATION ENGAGING IN THE BUSINESS OF ELECTRICAL CONTRACTING UNDER THIS SUBTITLE MAY NOT UNDERTAKE TO DO ANY ELECTRICAL WORK WITHIN THIS COUNTY UNLESS THE PERSON, FIRM, OR CORPORATION CARRIES GENERAL LIABILITY INSURANCE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$300,000 AND PROPERTY DAMAGE INSURANCE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$100,000.

B. PROOF OF INSURANCE SHALL BE SHOWN PRIOR TO THE ISSUANCE OR THE RENEWAL OF A LICENSE.

C. NOTICE OF CANCELLATION OF GENERAL LIABILITY INSURANCE OR PROPERTY DAMAGE INSURANCE SHALL BE FORWARDED TO THE BOARD WITHIN 10 DAYS OF THE CANCELLATION DATE.

D. INACTIVE LICENSE HOLDERS ARE EXEMPT FROM THIS REQUIREMENT.

38-22.

ANY CHANGE OF NAME, ADDRESS, OR EMPLOYMENT BY A LICENSEE FROM THAT WHICH APPEARS ON THE CURRENT LICENSE MUST BE REPORTED TO THE BOARD, IN WRITING, WITHIN 10 DAYS OF THE CHANGE.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1987.
