(1) THE ADMINISTRATION:

- (I) 1. REVIEWS THE CURRENT AIRPORT NOISE ZONE AND ABATEMENT PROCEDURES, SUCH REVIEWS TO INCLUDE AN EXAMINATION AND AN EVALUATION OF RUNWAY CURFEWS; AND
- 2. UPDATES THE NOISE ZONE AS PROPOSED BY THE ADMINISTRATION ON FEBRUARY 25, 1987;
- (II) ADOPTS THE PROPOSED NOISE ASSISTANCE RESIDENTIAL AREAS WITHIN THE AIRPORT NOISE ZONE PROGRAMS FOR INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO:
- 1. EXTENSION OF THE VOLUNTARY ACQUISITION PROGRAM;
- ZONING APPEALS ESTABLISHED BY SUBTITLE -8-BOARD OF OF THIS TITLE, STRENGTHENING OF ZONING PERMIT PROCEDURES AS NECESSARY: AND
- ESTABLISHMENT OF A HOMEOWNER ASSISTANCE PROGRAM: AND
- (III) IMPLEMENTS A PILOT PROGRAM OF HOMEOWNER ASSISTANCE IN FISCAL YEAR 1988; AND
-) THE STATE HIGHWAY ADMINISTRATION COMPLET OF THE FOLLOWING HIGHWAY PROJECTS REQUIRED HIGHWAY ADMINISTRATION COMPLETES CONSTRUCTION CONJUNCTION WITH AIRPORT IMPROVEMENTS:
- (I) HAMMONDS FERRY ROAD/POPLAR AVENUE INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS;
 - (II) MD 170/POPLAR AVENUE INTERSECTION;
 - (III) POPLAR AVENUE WIDENING;
 - (IV) MD 176 WIDENINGS;
 - (V) MD 176/HAMMONDS FERRY ROAD INTERSECTION;
 - (VI) NURSERY ROAD/MD 295 INTERCHANGE; AND
 - (VII) MD 3/MD 176 INTERCHANGE (AUXILIARY LANE).
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the State Aviation Administration shall report to the 1988 Session of the General Assembly the results of the pilot program required under § 5-413(c)(l)(iii) of the Transportation Article, along with recommendations for continuation of funding as part of the Fiscal Year 1989 departmental budget request.
