48B.

(b) A beneficiary and their designated beneficiaries, other than designated beneficiaries in receipt of an option 1 or option 4 benefit, may participate, as provided by this section, in the State [Employees] EMPLOYEES' Health Insurance Program provided that the beneficiary:

(1) (i) Retired directly from State service with a State retirement allowance from July 1, 1984; and

(ii) Had at least 5 years of creditable service;

(2) Terminated State service with 16 years or more of creditable service;

(3) Terminated State service prior to July 1, 1984;  
or

(4) Terminated State service with 10 years of creditable service and within 5 years of normal retirement age.

48C.

(a) An eligible employee who has retired under Article 73B, § 110 of the Code may participate in the State [Employees] EMPLOYEES' Health Insurance Program as provided by this section.

(d) (1) The Secretary of Personnel shall serve as a continuing member of the [Board] ADVISORY COUNCIL.

(2) Other members of the Advisory Council shall serve for a 2-year term on a staggered basis.
