- (B) "COUNCIL" MEANS THE STATE COORDINATING COUNCIL FOR RESIDENTIAL PLACEMENT OF HANDICAPPED CHILDREN.
 - (C) "DIRECTOR" MEANS THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE COUNCIL.
- (D) "LOCAL COORDINATING COUNCIL" MEANS A LOCAL COORDINATING COUNCIL FOR RESIDENTIAL PLACEMENT OF HANDICAPPED CHILDREN.

THERE IS A STATE COORDINATING COUNCIL FOR RESIDENTIAL PLACEMENT OF HANDICAPPED CHILDREN WITHIN THE OFFICE FOR HANDICAPPED INDIVIDUALS IN THE EXECUTIVE BRANCH OF THE GOVERNMENT.

- (A) THE MEMBERS OF THE COUNCIL ARE:
- (1) THE SECRETARY OF HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE OR THE SECRETARY'S DESIGNEE;
- (2) THE SECRETARY OF HUMAN RESOURCES OR THE SECRETARY'S DESIGNEE;
- (3) THE STATE SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS OR THE SUPERINTENDENT'S DESIGNEE; AND
- (4) THE DIRECTOR OF THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE FOR THE COORDINATION OF SERVICES TO THE HANDICAPPED, AS A NONVOTING, EX OFFICIO MEMBER; AND
- YOUTH, AS A NONVOTING, EX OFFICIO MEMBER.
- (B) (1) THERE IS A CHAIRMAN OF THE COUNCIL WHO SHALL SERVE A TERM OF 12 MONTHS IN 3 YEAR CYCLES OF ROTATION AS PROVIDED IN THIS SUBSECTION.
- (2) THE SECRETARY OF HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE IS THE CHAIRMAN OF THE COUNCIL FOR A TERM OF 12 CONSECUTIVE MONTHS BEGINNING ON JULY 1, 1982 1987. THE SECRETARY OF HUMAN RESOURCES SHALL SUCCEED THE SECRETARY OF HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE AS CHAIRMAN FOR A TERM OF 12 CONSECUTIVE MONTHS, AND THE STATE SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS SHALL SUCCEED THE SECRETARY OF HUMAN RESOURCES FOR A TERM OF 12 CONSECUTIVE MONTHS.
- (3) AFTER THE INITIAL 3 YEAR CYCLE OF ROTATION OF THE OFFICE OF CHAIRMAN, EACH VOTING MEMBER SHALL SERVE AS CHAIRMAN FOR A 12- MONTH TERM IN THE ORDER SET FORTH IN PARAGRAPH 2 OF THIS SUBSECTION.
