FOR the purpose of quaranteeing-against-loss-of-property-value-by establishing--and--providing--for--the-funding-of-an-Airport Noise-Zone-Acquisition--Fund; -- requiring--the--Secretary--of Transportation-or-the-Secretary's-designee-to-administer-and control--the--Fund; --requiring--the--Fund-to-be-used-for-the purchase-and-resale-of-certain-properties,-or-to--compensate for--loss--of---property--value-located-in-the-airport-noise zone;-requiring-the-Fund-to-be-a-revolving--fund;--requiring that---the---contract---of---sale---contain--certain--notice requirements-and-that-such-notice-requirement-constitutes-an easement;-establishing-the-Board-of-Airport--Zoning--Appeals as--the--panel--to--review-certain-appeals;-defining-certain terms; -and --generally -- relating -- to -- the -- establishment -- and funding---of---the---Airport--Noise--Bone--Acquisition--Fund establishing a program for the voluntary acquisition of residentially used real property and to assure the resale of real property within a certain area of the Baltimore-Washington International Airport Noise establishing a Homeowners Assistance Pilot Program; requiring a report by the State Aviation Administration the General Assembly; requiring certain property owners to grant an avigation easement to the Administration under certain circumstances; restricting the variance granting power of the Board of Airport Zoning Appeals under certain circumstances; defining certain terms; and generally relating to the establishment of noise assistance programs addressing residential areas within the Baltimore-Washington International Airport Noise Zone.
