CHAPTER 586

(Senate Bill 201)

AN ACT concerning

Allegany County - Sunday Blue Laws

FOR the purpose of allowing certain wholesale and retail establishments in Allegany County to conduct business on Sunday; providing certain exceptions; defining certain terms; establishing a procedure permitting certain employees to choose their day of rest or Sabbath without being penalized by their employer; providing certain penalties and an injunctive relief procedure; generally relating to Allegany County and Sunday business prohibitions; providing that the provisions of this Act are severable; and submitting this Act to a referendum of the legally qualified voters of Allegany County.
