Nothing contained in §§ 492 and 522 of this article shall be construed to prohibit or make unlawful the exhibition within Wicomico County of baseball and motion pictures between the hours of 1:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m. and 9:00 p.m. and midnight, or the operation within Wicomico County of any bowling alley, tenpin alley, or duckpin alley between the hours of 2:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m. and 9:00 p.m. and midnight, on the first day of the week, commonly called Sunday, whether the same be exhibited with or without a charge or admission fee; provided, however, that all baseball and motion pictures exhibited and all bowling alleys, tenpin alleys, or duckpin alleys operated shall be subject to all provisions of law relating to licensing and censorship applicable to baseball and motion picture exhibitions and to bowling alley, tenpin alley, or duckpin alley operations on weekdays. The work or employment of any operator, ticket seller or any other employees or attendants in connection with any such exhibition of baseball and motion pictures or any such operation of a bowling alley, tenpin alley, or duckpin alley shall not be unlawful because performed on Sundays. Any exhibition of motion pictures and baseball or operation of bowling alleys, tenpin alleys, or duckpin alleys on Sundays, except as hereby authorized, shall be unlawful and subject to the provision and penalties of said §§ 492 and 522 of this article.-f-

Nothing contained in §§ 492 and 522 of this article shall be construed to prohibit to make unlawful the operation within Worcester County of any bowling alley, duckpin alley or tenpin alley or the exhibition within Worcester County of baseball and motion pictures between the hours of 2:00 p.m. and midnight on the first day of the week, commonly called Sunday, whether the same be operated or exhibited with or without a charge or admission fee, provided, however, that all bowling, duckpin or tenpin alleys shall be subject to all applicable provisions of law relating to licensing and regulation on weekdays and that all baseball and motion pictures exhibited shall be subject to all provisions of law relating to licensing and censorship applicable to baseball and motion picture exhibitions on weekdays. The work or employment of any operator, ticket seller or any other employees or attendants in connection with any such operation of a bowling, duckpin or tenpin alley, or such exhibition of baseball and motion pictures shall not be unlawful because performed on Sundays. Any operation of bowling, duckpin or tenpin alleys or exhibition of motion pictures and baseball on Sundays, except as hereby authorized shall be unlawful and subject to the provisions and penalties of said §§ 492 and 522 of this article.
