(ii) Satisfactory evidence of compliance with any continuing education requirements set under this section for license renewal.

14-403.

- (a) A majority of the full authorized membership of the Commission is a quorum to do all business.
- (b) The Commission shall determine the times and places of its meetings.
 - (c) Each member of the Commission is entitled to:
- (1) Compensation, in accordance with the State budget, for each day the member is engaged in performing the duties of the Commission; and
- (2) Reimbursement for expenses under the Standard State Travel Regulations, as provided in the State budget.
 - (d) The Commission may maintain an office in this State.
- (e) The Commission may employ a staff in accordance with the State budget. The Commission may designate one of its staff as an executive director.
- (F) THE COMMISSION SHALL BE ASSIGNED AN ASSISTANT ATTORNEY GENERAL BY THE ATTORNEY GENERAL TO ASSIST IN THE INVESTIGATION, DEVELOPMENT, AND PROSECUTION OF CASES REFERRED TO THE COMMISSION.

14-504.

Subject to the hearing provisions of § 14-505 of this subtitle, the Commission, on the affirmative vote of a majority of its full authorized membership, may reprimand any licensee, place any licensee on probation, or suspend or revoke a license if the licensee:

- (1) Fraudulently or deceptively obtains or attempts to obtain a license for the applicant or licensee or for another;
 - (2) Fraudulently or deceptively uses a license;
- (3) Is guilty of immoral conduct in the practice of medicine;
- (4) Is professionally, physically, or mentally incompetent;
- (5) Solicits or advertises in violation of § 14-604 of this title;
