THE DEPARTMENT HAS JURISDICTION OVER:

- (1) THE AREA #MMED!ATELY SURROUNDING ANY SOURCE FROM WHICH DRINKING WATER IS COLLECTED FOR DELIVERY IN CONTAINERS; AND
- (2) METHODS OF COLLECTING, BOTTLING, AND DELIVERING DRINKING WATER IN CONTAINERS.
- (B) COLLECTING, BOTTLING, OR DELIVERING DRINKING WATER IN CONTAINERS -- PERMIT REQUIRED; APPROVAL OF DEPARTMENT.
- (1) NO DRINKING WATER MAY BE COLLECTED, BOTTLED, OR DELIVERED IN CONTAINERS UNTIL A PERMIT HAS BEEN ISSUED BY THE DEPARTMENT TO THE OWNER OF THE WATER SUPPLY.
- (2) IF THE DEPARTMENT FINDS THAT THE WATER IS INJURIOUS TO PUBLIC HEALTH, THE DEPARTMENT MAY NOT ISSUE A PERMIT UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION.
 - (C) SAME -- PROHIBITED WITHOUT PERMIT.
- A PERSON MAY NOT COLLECT, BOTTLE, OR DELIVER IN CONTAINERS DRINKING WATER FROM A WATER SUPPLY UNLESS THE OWNER OF THE WATER SUPPLY HAS A PERMIT UNDER SUBSECTION (B)(1) OF THIS SECTION.
- (D) SELLING DRINKING WATER FROM OUTSIDE THIS STATE -- PERMIT REQUIRED; QUALIFICATIONS; POWERS OF DEPARTMENT.
- (1) A PERSON WHO HANDLES DRINKING WATER TRANSPORTED IN CONTAINERS FROM OUTSIDE THIS STATE SHALL HAVE A PERMIT FROM THE DEPARTMENT BEFORE THE PERSON SELLS THE DRINKING WATER IN THIS STATE.
- (2) TO QUALIFY FOR A PERMIT UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION, A PERSON SHALL PRESENT TO THE DEPARTMENT A PERMIT THAT WAS ISSUED BY THE APPROPRIATE AUTHORITY OF THE STATE IN WHICH THE WATER WAS COLLECTED AND THAT SHOWS THAT:
- (I) THE WATER SUPPLY AND THE METHOD OF HANDLING THE WATER, AS PRACTICED IN THE OTHER STATE, IS NOT PREJUDICIAL TO PUBLIC HEALTH; AND
- (II) THE WATER CAN BE SOLD LAWFULLY IN THE OTHER STATE.
- (3) THIS SUBSECTION DOES NOT PREVENT THE DEPARTMENT FROM PROHIBITING THE USE OF WATER SHIPPED FROM OUTSIDE THIS STATE IF:
- (I) IN THE JUDGMENT OF THE DEPARTMENT) THE WATER IS SHOWN BY ANALYSIS TO BE UNFIT FOR DRINKING; OR
