- (a) The Board shall annually select the 300 secondary school students who have the greatest potential for academic success in higher education as determined by criteria established by the Board and offer scholarships to these students to be used at any Maryland postsecondary institution of their choice, if they meet the following qualifications:
 - (1) Qualify academically as follows:
- (i) Have a secondary school transcript indicating an overall academic grade point average of at least 3.7 on a 4.0 scale or its equivalent grade point average; or
- (ii) Are [a finalist] FINALISTS of the National Merit Scholarship Program or the Achievement Scholarship Program administered by the National Merit Scholarship Corporation; or
- (iii) Have superior creative talent or skill in art, music, dance, or the theater, as determined by an audition or portfolio review process established by the Board.
