SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## Article - Estates and Trusts

5-601.

- (a) If the property of the decedent subject to administration in Maryland is established to have a gross value of [\$10,000] \$20,000 or less as of the date of the death of the decedent, the estate may be administered in accordance with the provisions of §§ 5-602 through 5-607.
- (b) If, before the filing of an initial account administration proceedings instituted under Subtitle 3 Subtitle 4 of this title, the property of the decedent subject to administration in Maryland is established to have a gross value of [\$10,000] \$20,000 or less as of the date of the death of the decedent, the estate thereafter may be administered in accordance with the provisions of §§ 5-602 through 5-607.
- An inheritance tax is not due or payable on a distribution from such estate.

5-603.

- (a) If the register finds that the petition and additional information filed in the proceeding is accurate, he shall:
- (1) Direct that the petitioner serve as personal representative of the small estate AND ISSUE ADDITIONAL LETTERS OF ADMINISTRATION AS NEEDED;
- (b)-(1)--If-the-register-directs-a-proceeding-in--accordance with-subsection--(a)(4),--unless--notice-of-the-appointment-of-a personal-representative-appointed-under-Subtitle-3-or-Subtitle--4 of--this--title-has-been-published-one-or-more-times-notice-shall be-given-once-in-the-form-required-by-9--7-1037--but--the--period within-which-objection-must-be-made-to-the-action-or-within-which claims-must-be-filed-is-{30}-60-days-from-the-date-of-publication of-notice.

Property of the decedent discovered after the filing of the petition shall be reported immediately by supplemental petition. If no administration was had in accordance with § 5-603(a)(4) because of the failure to include after-discovered property in the original petition, the register shall direct appropriate
