SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Health Occupations

3-302.

(c) Except as otherwise provided in this title, the applicant shall:

(1) Have completed satisfactorily:

(i) 2 academic years at a college or university approved by the State Board for Higher Education or by a comparable authority in another state; and

(ii) At least two of the following college courses:

1. Biology;
2. Chemistry; or
3. Physics; and

(2) (I) Be a graduate of a school of chiropractic [that]:

~~(i)~~ THAT has been approved by the Board under § 3-402 of this title; OR

~~(ii) -- THAT HAS BEEN APPROVED BY THE BOARD -- UNDER § -- 3-402 -- OF -- THIS -- TITLE -- WITHIN -- 3 -- YEARS AFTER THE APPLICANT'S GRADUATION; -- OR -- COUNCIL ON CHIROPRACTIC EDUCATION WITHIN -- 4 -- YEARS AFTER -- THE -- APPLICANT -- GRADUATED FROM THAT SCHOOL AND LICENSED IN ANOTHER STATE FOR 2 YEARS;~~

(II) 1. BE LICENSED IN ANOTHER STATE FOR AT LEAST 2 YEARS; AND
