- (b) Public entities may pool together for the purpose of purchasing casualty <u>OR PROPERTY</u> insurance or self-insuring casualty <u>OR PROPERTY</u> risks.
- (C) ATHLETIC ASSOCIATIONS CLUBS, CHARITABLE ORGANIZATIONS, COMMUNITY ASSOCIATIONS, AND HOMEOWNERS ASSOCIATIONS MAY POOL TOGETHER FOR THE PURPOSE OF PURCHASING CASUALTY OR PROPERTY INSURANCE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1987.

(Senate Bill 664)

AN ACT concerning

Chesapeake Bay Critical Area Program -Assistance to Local Jurisdictions
