## CHAPTER 636

(Senate Bill 735)

AN ACT concerning

Major Medical Equipment - Licensure

FOR the purpose of removing a certain licensing exemption for health maintenance organizations; and extending the termination date for the laws relating to licensing requirements for certain major medical equipment.

BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments,

Article - Health - General Section 19-1001 and-19-1002 Annotated Code of Maryland (1982 Volume and 1986 Supplement)

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article - Health - General Section 19-1002 and 19-1008 Annotated Code of Maryland (1982 Volume and 1986 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Health - General

19-1001.

- (a) In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated.
- (b) "License" means a license issued by the Secretary to operate major medical equipment.
- (c) "Major medical equipment" means medical equipment that is used to provide health care services and for which the total cost of the equipment exceeds \$600,000 after adjustment for inflation as provided in regulations adopted by the Secretary.
- (d) (1) "Provisional license" means a license issued by the Secretary to operate major medical equipment for which licensing standards have not yet been adopted.
- (2) A provisional license shall only be valid until regulations establishing licensing standards are in effect.
