The Department may not adopt regulations to implement Stage II of the [Vapor Recovery Control System for fuel pumps] PROGRAM FOR VOLATILE ORGANIC EMISSIONS CONTROL FROM GASOLINE RETAILING OPERATIONS unless:

- (1) The Department is mandated by the United States Environmental Protection Agency;
- (2) The Department is unable to find other control strategies; and
- (3) The Environmental Protection Agency publishes notice in the Federal Register that the State of Maryland is not in compliance with the provisions of the Clean Air Act ([42 U.S.C. § 7401 through 7602] 42 U.S.C. §§ 7401 THROUGH 7602).
