(a) All expenditures from the State Hazardous Substance Control Fund made by the Department under [§ 7-220(b)(1), (2), (3), (4), and (5)] § 7-220(B) of this subtitle in response to a release or a threatened release of a controlled hazardous substance at a particular site shall be reimbursed to the Department for the State Hazardous Substance Control Fund by the responsible person for the release or the threatened release.
