[(d)] (E) A contract entered into or purchase made in violation of this section is void.

Montgomery County Board of Education - Procurement -
Products from South Africa

FOR the purpose of authorizing the Montgomery County Board of Education to provide in its bid specifications that a product grown, mined, or manufactured in the Republic of South Africa may be rejected; permitting the Montgomery County Board of Education to reject a bid for a product grown, mined, or manufactured in the Republic of South Africa; and generally relating to the procurement process of the Montgomery County Board of Education.
