

WHEREAS, Prince George's County's heritage has been enriched by past accomplishments and contributions of private preservation organizations and their continuing activities are in the public interest; now, therefore,

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

SUBTITLE 3. PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY HISTORIC
PROPERTY GRANT PROGRAM

(A) IN THIS SUBTITLE THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.

(B) "BOARD" MEANS THE PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY BOARD OF THE MARYLAND-NATIONAL CAPITAL PARK AND PLANNING COMMISSION.

(C) "FUND" MEANS THE PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY HISTORIC PROPERTY GRANT FUND.

(D) "HISTORIC PROPERTY" MEANS A DISTRICT, SITE, BUILDING, STRUCTURE, OR OBJECT SIGNIFICANT IN THE PREHISTORY, HISTORY, UPLAND AND UNDERWATER ARCHAEOLOGY, ARCHITECTURE, ENGINEERING, AND CULTURE OF THE STATE, INCLUDING ARTIFACTS, RECORDS, AND REMAINS RELATED TO A DISTRICT, SITE, BUILDING, STRUCTURE, OR OBJECT.

(E) "PRESERVATION" MEANS THE IDENTIFICATION, EVALUATION, RECORDATION, DOCUMENTATION, CURATION, ACQUISITION, PROTECTION, MANAGEMENT, REHABILITATION, RESTORATION, STABILIZATION, MAINTENANCE, AND RECONSTRUCTION OF AN HISTORIC PROPERTY.

(F) "PROGRAM" MEANS THE PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY HISTORIC PROPERTY GRANT PROGRAM.

(A) THERE IS A PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY HISTORIC PROPERTY GRANT PROGRAM.

(B) THE PURPOSE OF THE PROGRAM IS TO:

(1) PRESERVE, PROTECT, AND ENHANCE HISTORIC PROPERTIES;

(2) ENCOURAGE OTHERS TO PRESERVE, PROTECT, AND ENHANCE HISTORIC PROPERTIES; AND
