In addition to any other license required by law, a person shall be licensed by the Administration before the person may provide the following services to an individual with developmental disability or a recipient of individual support services:

- (1) Day habilitation services;
- (2) Residential services;
- (3) Services coordination;
- (4) Vocational services;
- (5) More than 1 family support service, as defined under § 7-701 of this [subtitle] TITLE; and
- (6) More than 1 individual support service.
