SECTION--1.--BE--IF--ENACTED--BY--THE--GENERAL--ASSEMBLY--OF  
MARYLAND,-That-the-Laws-of-Maryland-read-as-follows:

Article-88B---State-Police

(A)--The--administration--of--the--retirement--and--pension  
system,-established-by-this-subtitle,-is-hereby-vested-in-the  
Superintendent-of-State-Police,-who-shall-keep-separate-records  
and-accounts-and-report-his-receipts-and-disbursements-hereunder  
in-the-same-manner-as-is-provided-in-this-article-for-other  
receipts-and-disbursements-of-his-department.

(B)--The--Superintendent--of--State--Police-shall-receive-no  
additional-compensation-for-these-duties,-but-shall-be-reimbursed  
for-all-necessary-expenses-which-he-may-sustain-through-his  
service-in-administering-this-subtitle,-and-all-claims-for  
reimbursement-shall-be-subject-to-the-approval-of-the-Legislative  
Auditor.-And-there-shall-be-no-additional-paid-employees-engaged  
for-the-administration-of-this-subtitle.
