SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Health - General

7-206:

- (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.
- (2) "DIRECT CARE STAFF" MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS DIRECTLY INVOLVED IN THE DAY-TO-DAY EDUCATION, TRAINING, HABILITATION, ASSISTANCE, COUNSELING, CARE, OR ATTENTION OF AN INDIVIDUAL WITH A DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITY.
- (3)--"PROGRAM"--MEANS--THE--DIRECT---CARE---IN-SERVICE TRAINING-PROGRAM.
- (B) (1) THE DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES ADMINISTRATION SHALL BEVELOP-AND-IMPLEMENT-AN-IN-SERVICE-TRAINING-PROGRAM-FOR ASSURE THAT ALL DIRECT CARE STAFF IN STATE RESIDENTIAL AND COMMUNITY BASED PROGRAMS ARE PROVIDED WITH IN-SERVICE TRAINING.
- (2) THE IN-SERVICE TRAINING PROGRAM SHALL INCLUDE TRAINING IN:
- (I) THE THEORY AND PRACTICAL APPLICATION OF NORMALIZATION PRINCIPLES:
 - (II) THE INDIVIDUALIZATION OF PROGRAMMING:
- (III) GENERAL CHARACTERISTICS AND NEEDS OF INDIVIDUALS SERVED;
- (IV) FIRST AID AND CARDIO-PULMONARY RESUSCITATION (CPR); AND
- (V) THE FUNDAMENTAL RIGHTS OF PERSONS WITH DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES; AND
