(House Bill 1038)

AN ACT concerning

Associations and Organizations - Immunity

FOR the purpose of prohibiting imposition of personal liability for damages on certain agents of certain associations and organizations under certain circumstances; providing conditions under which personal liability for damages may and may not be imposed on agents of certain associations and organizations in certain cases; providing for the applicability of this Act; defining certain terms; and generally relating to certain associations and organizations.
