

OWNER'S RIGHTS, TO RECOVER DAMAGES, OR TO TAKE AND RECOVER THE RETURNABLE CONTAINERS OR ARTICLES FROM ANY PERSON WHO UNLAWFULLY POSSESSES THE PROPERTY OF THE OWNER.

(B) NOTHING CONTAINED IN THIS SUBTITLE SHALL BE CONSTRUED AS PROHIBITING A PROSECUTION FOR THEFT UNDER § 342 OF THIS ARTICLE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1987.

CHAPTER 748

(Senate Bill 152)

AN ACT concerning

Procurement - Resident Business Preferences

FOR the purpose of revising the resident business preference provision of the State procurement law by authorizing a procurement agency, when awarding a contract by competitive bidding, to give certain advantages to a Maryland firm over certain nonresident firms under certain circumstances; authorizing political subdivisions and certain entities to grant a residence business preference when awarding contracts by competitive bidding; and generally relating to preferences for Maryland firms in the award of contracts by competitive bidding under the State procurement law.
