(b) (2) "Doing business with or in South Africa" does not include companies or persons who are completing a limited consulting contract in existence on [the date of enactment of this subtitle] JANUARY 1, 1987, in South Africa that was entered into as a result of the company divesting itself of all business property and operations in South Africa.
