(a) (1) After each regular session, the Department shall compile and index:

(i) the laws that are enacted during that session;

(ii) the executive orders that have been delivered to the Department under § 3-405 of this article since the last compilation;

(iii) the certificates of the [Secretary of State] ADMINISTRATIVE BOARD OF ELECTION LAWS as to the referendum vote on a law, if the vote has not been published previously; and
