RESOLVED, That the Task Force on Mandated Health Insurance Benefits have the following charge:

(1) To investigate the impact of mandated benefit laws on the people of this State to determine both the benefits derived from, and the economic and social costs relating, to these laws;

(2) To develop a coherent policy and statutory structure with respect to mandated health insurance benefits; and

(3) To recommend legislation to implement the policy developed by the Task Force; and be it further
