- (4) Review bank loan programs and management assistance services to ensure that the women-owned and minority-owned business community is aware of all the forms of assistance available;
- (5) Examine and make recommendations for the creation of a venture capital network or other mechanism that provides access to capital;
- (6) Examine incubator programs designed for women <u>and</u> minority business entrepeneurs entrepreneurs;
- (7) Identify problem areas that inhibit the ability of women and minorities to participate fully in business; and
  - (8) Make recommendations; and be it further
