This bill lists specific data that an insurer must submit in an annual report to the Insurance Commissioner, in a format prescribed by the Commissioner, containing its liability experience in Maryland and other states.

House Bill 243, which was passed by the General Assembly and signed by me on June 2, 1987, accomplishes the same purpose. Therefore, it is not necessary for me to sign Senate Bill 236.
