VETOES

In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, I have today vetoed Senate Bill 252.

This bill adds Somerset, Worcester and Wicomico Counties to counties where it is prohibited to use artificial lights from vehicles for observing or photographing wildlife until 9:00 p.m.

House Bill 184, which was passed by the General Assembly and signed by me on April 29, 1987, accomplishes the same purpose. Therefore, it is not necessary for me to sign Senate Bill 252.
