VETOES

(II) INTEREST ON THE TOTAL TAX LIABILITY AS REQUIRED UNDER § 14-605 OF THIS ARTICLE; AND

(III) A TAX PENALTY AS REQUIRED UNDER § 14-703 OF THIS ARTICLE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1987.

In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, I have today vetoed Senate Bill 294.

AN ACT concerning

Vietnam Veterans - Awards Recognition

FOR the purpose of authorizing the Governor to award issue medals or certificates to citizens of the State who served with the armed-forces in the Vietnam conflict; and generally relating to the award of medals and certificates to veterans.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
