In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, I have today vetoed House Bill 398.

Senate Bill 163, which was passed by the General Assembly and signed by me on May 14, 1987, accomplishes the same purpose. Therefore, it is not necessary for me to sign House Bill 398.
