In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, I have today vetoed House Bill 1125.

This bill increases the minimum amount of capital investment that is required for a restaurant in Prince George's County to qualify for a Class BLX alcoholic beverages license.

Senate Bill 69, which was passed by the General Assembly and signed by me on May 14, 1987, accomplishes the same purpose. Therefore, it is not necessary for me to sign House Bill 1125.
