(b) The governing boards of the institutions shall determine which credit cards are acceptable for this purpose. However, a public institution may not accept a credit card from any credit card company which charges that institution a vendor discount, service charge or similar fee in excess of 2.5 percent.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1987.

(Senate Bill 147)

AN ACT concerning

Surveyors - Examinations

FOR the purpose of eliminating the requirement that examinations of land surveyors given by the State Board of Registration for Professional Land Surveyors be of a specific duration.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article 56 - Licenses Section 335 Annotated Code of Maryland (1983 Replacement Volume and 1986 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 56 - Licenses

335.

(a) Application for registration as a professional land surveyor or for certification as a land surveyor-in-training or for registration as a property line surveyor shall be on a form prescribed and furnished by the Board. The application shall contain statements made under oath showing the applicant's education and a detailed summary of his technical experience and not less than five references, including, unless excused by the Board, at least three professional land surveyors having personal knowledge of his land surveying experience. The application also shall contain or be accompanied by any other relevant material or information. The following shall be considered as minimum
