(E) A WINERY MAY NOT HOST MORE THAN 6 EVENTS UNDER THIS SECTION PER CALENDAR YEAR.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1987.

CHAPTER 38

(Senate Bill 388)

AN ACT concerning

Wicomico County - Alcoholic Beverages Licenses -
Legal Drinking Age

FOR the purpose of defining the term "lounge area"; requiring authorizing the holder of a Class B beer, wine and liquor restaurant or hotel or restaurant license in Wicomico County to prohibit a person under the legal drinking age in the State from entering the lounge area on the licensed premises after a certain time unless accompanied by a certain person of a certain age; and providing that the Wicomico County Board of License Commissioners may impose a certain penalty upon a finding of guilt for violating this restriction permitting an entertainment fee to be charged under certain circumstances.
