RESOLUTION NO. 50

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF EASTON TO REPEAL AND RE-ENACT, WITH AMENDMENTS, ARTICLE II, SECTION 1 OF THE CHARTER OF THE TOWN OF EASTON; THE EFFECT OF SAID AMENDMENTS BEING TO DELETE THEREFROM THE PROVISIONS REQUIRING A MEMBER OF THE TOWN COUNCIL TO HAVE BEEN A QUALIFIED VOTER OF THE TOWN OF EASTON FOR AT LEAST TWO YEARS NEXT PRECEDING HIS ELECTION AND A RESIDENT OF THE WARD FOR WHICH HE IS ELECTED FOR AT LEAST ONE YEAR NEXT PRECEDING HIS ELECTION AND, IN LIEU OF SAID REQUIREMENTS, TO PROVIDE THAT A MEMBER OF THE EASTON TOWN COUNCIL BE A REGISTERED VOTER OF THE TOWN OF EASTON AT THE TIME OF HIS FILING A NOMINATION PETITION FOR ELECTION TO OFFICE AND THAT EACH MEMBER WHO REPRESENTS A WARD
