Metal Inc. and in part by the lands of Preston Trucking Company, bounded on the south in part by the lands of Preston Trucking Company, by the lands of Thomas and Mary Todd and by the corporate limit, encompassing a part of West Salisbury Parkway, the lands of G. Robert Miller, the lands of Robert M. Duncan and the lands of Helen F. Taylor Johnson.
