RESOLUTION NO. 293

A RESOLUTION of the Council of the City of Salisbury, proposing the annexation to the City of Salisbury of a certain area of land situated contiguous to and binding upon the easterly corporate limits of the City of Salisbury, popularly known as the "U.S. Route 50 East Annexation #3" bounded on the south by Route 50 east; bounded on the east by Route 13 by-pass; bounded on the west by the lands of Emmanuel Wesleyan Church and encompassing the lands of Brice R. and Shirley F. Phillips; the southern part of the lands of James W. Brittingham; the lands of Second National Building & Loan Incorporated; the lands of C. Wilkins and Anne F. Powell, the land of Wicomico Medical Services Corporation; the lands of Olin J. Parker, Jr.; the lands of the Catholic Diocese of Wilmington Foundation; the lands of Jason S. Sr. and Elsie H. Tilghman; the land of Jason S. Jr. and Diane B. Tilghman; and the lands of Edward G. Bounds, Jr.; the land of Chester C. Jr. and Elaine Collins and others.

Johnson and Gracious Chicken Inc. and a section of Beaglin Park Drive, said proposed area being contiguous and adjoining to the existing corporate limits.
