AN ACT concerning

Zoning Regulations - 0-1 and 0-2 Zones

FOR the purpose of allowing certain accessory commercial uses in the 0-1 and 0-2 Zones; altering the bulk regulations and floor area limitations of such uses; defining terms; and generally relating to commercial uses in 0-1 and 0-2 Zones.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Section 101 - the definitions of "Floor area, adjusted gross" and "Office Building, Class B", and  
Section 204.4.B., 205.3.A., 205.3.B., 205.3.C.i., 205.4.A., and 205.4.C.

AN ACT concerning

Zoning Regulations - Storage of Motor Vehicles

FOR the purpose of prohibiting the storage of an inoperative motor vehicle on a residential lot; authorizing the storage of an unlicensed vehicle on a residential lot under certain conditions; and defining terms.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Section 101 - Definitions, by adding the definition of "~~commercial vehicle~~ UNLICENSED MOTOR VEHICLE" and "inoperative motor vehicle" and amending the definition of "Junk Yard"  
Baltimore County Zoning Regulations, as amended
