REPAIR, OR DEMOLITION OF STRUCTURES AT CERTAIN TIMES;

(10) TO TRANSFORM STANDARDS FOR THE ADMISSIBILITY OF EVIDENCE IN COURT INTO STANDARDS FOR THE ACCURACY OF MEASUREMENTS OF SOUND LEVELS;

(11) TO CHANGE THE HOURS DURING WHICH SOUNDS ASSOCIATED WITH RESIDENTIAL LIVING MUST BE TOLERATED;

(12) TO EXCLUDE REPAIRS ON OFF-ROAD VEHICLES AND OTHER RESIDENTIAL ACTIVITIES SPECIFIED IN REGULATIONS FROM THE CATEGORY OF SOUNDS ASSOCIATED WITH RESIDENTIAL LIVING;

(13) TO PROHIBIT CREATING NOISE DISTURBANCE ACROSS A RESIDENTIAL PROPERTY LINE OR ON A MULTI-FAMILY RESIDENTIAL STRUCTURE BY SOUNDS ASSOCIATED WITH RESIDENTIAL LIVING AND BY VARIOUS OTHER MEANS;

(14) TO REPEAL THE REQUIREMENT THAT MOTOR VEHICLES HAVE MUFFLERS;

(15) TO PROHIBIT CREATING A NOISE DISTURBANCE ACROSS A RESIDENTIAL PROPERTY LINE BY HANDLING CONTAINERS AND CONSTRUCTION MATERIAL AND EQUIPMENT BETWEEN 9:00 P.M. AND 7:00 A.M. MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY AND BETWEEN 9:00 P.M. AND 9:00 A.M. ON SATURDAYS, SUNDAYS, AND FEDERAL HOLIDAYS;

(16) TO CHANGE THE HOURS FOR SALE BY PUBLIC OUTCRY AND USE OF MUSICAL INSTRUMENTS IN THE STREET FROM BETWEEN 8:00 A.M. AND 9:00 P.M. TO BETWEEN 7:00 A.M. AND 9:00 P.M. MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY AND BETWEEN 9:00 A.M. AND 9:00 P.M. ON SATURDAYS, SUNDAYS, AND FEDERAL HOLIDAYS;

(17) TO PROHIBIT CREATING A NOISE DISTURBANCE ON PUBLIC PROPERTY BY AN ELECTRONIC DEVICE;

(18) TO PROVIDE A DEADLINE FOR APPLYING FOR A TEMPORARY EXEMPTION, PROCEDURES FOR THE DIRECTOR TO NOTIFY THE PUBLIC, AND TIME FOR PUBLIC COMMENT;

(19) TO ALLOW SPECIAL EXEMPTIONS THAT LAST UP TO 10 YEARS FOR TREATING PROPERTY IN A MIXED USE ZONE AS COMMERCIAL OR INDUSTRIAL PROPERTY;

(20) TO PROHIBIT A PERSON FROM ALLOWING THEIR ANIMAL TO CAUSE A NOISE DISTURBANCE;

(21) TO REPEAL OBSOLETE ENFORCEMENT PROCEDURES AND OTHER OBSOLETE PROVISIONS;

(22) TO MAKE CLARIFYING, STYLISTIC, AND TECHNICAL CHANGES; AND
