

MONTGOMERY COUNTY

- (1) to provide for voluntary registration of homeowners' associations, [[and]] municipal corporations, and special taxing districts with the department of environmental protection;
- (2) to require the department to make a list of registered homeowners' associations available to the public;
- (3) to require the department to ask about homeowners' associations, [[and]] municipal corporations, and special taxing districts during the permit process;
- (4) to require that the applicant state under [[oath]] penalty of perjury whether the proposed site is in a homeowners' association, [[or]] municipal corporation, or special taxing district;
- (5) to require the department to give notice to a homeowners' association, [[or]] municipal corporation, or special taxing district when a permit is issued under certain circumstances;
- (6) to provide that this legislation does not prohibit the department from issuing a building permit;
- (7) to require the County Executive to adopt regulations; and
- (8) to generally amend the process for issuing building permits for property in a homeowners' association, [[or]] municipal corporation, or special taxing district.
