- (a) (4) (I) All hotels and motels, regardless of the number of units, shall have available at least one smoke detector for the deaf or hearing impaired for each 50 units or less. The proprietor may require a refundable deposit for a portable smoke detector not to exceed the value of the smoke detector.
- (II) THE PROPRIETOR OF THE HOTEL OR MOTEL SHALL POST IN A CONSPICUOUS PLACE AT THE REGISTRATION DESK OR COUNTER A PERMANENT SIGN STATING THE AVAILABILITY OF SMOKE DETECTORS FOR THE HEARING IMPAIRED.
