LAWS OF MARYLAND

- (a) A Class B beer and light wine license shall be issued by the clerk of the circuit court of the county in which the place of business is located, and shall authorize the holder thereof to keep for sale and sell beer and light wines at retail at any hotel or restaurant, at the place therein described, for consumption on the premises or elsewhere. The annual fee for the license shall be \$60, and shall be payable to the clerk, before any license is issued, for distribution as herein provided.
- (i-1) (1) In Queen Anne's County the annual license fee is [\$200] \$500, but this license does not permit beer or light wine sales on Sundays.
- (2) In Queen Anne's County a licensee may purchase a "Sunday sale" Class B beer and light wine license for a fee of \$50.

16.

- (a) A Class D beer and light wine license shall be issued by the clerk of the circuit court of the county in which the place of business is located. The license authorizes its holder to keep for sale and to sell beer and light wines at retail, at the place described in the license, for consumption on the premises or elsewhere. The license may not be issued for any drugstore. The annual fee for the license is \$60, and shall be payable to the clerk, before any license is issued, for distribution as provided in this article.
- (s) In Queen Anne's County the annual fee for this license is [\$200] \$500.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1987.

CHAPTER 82

(House Bill 292)

AN ACT concerning

Queen Anne's County - Alcoholic Beverages License

FOR the purpose of authorizing in Queen Anne's County the issuance of a Class D beer, wine and liquor license for on-premises consumption only; setting the annual fee for
