CHAPTER 117

(House Bill 1142)

AN ACT concerning

Prince George's County - Snare Traps
PG 419-87

FOR the purpose of providing that a person may not use, sell, possess, set, place, or maintain a snare trap in Prince George's County; and generally relating to snare traps in Prince George's County.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article - Natural Resources
Section 10-410(p)
Annotated Code of Maryland
(1983 Replacement Volume and 1986 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Natural Resources

10-410.

(p) (1) (i) "Snare trap" means a device made of wire, synthetic cord, or other material that:

1. Is in the form of a noose with a slipknot, stop, swivel, or eyelet holes; and
2. Is designed or set with the intent of capturing an animal by the neck.

(ii) "Snare trap" includes:

1. A pole snare;
2. Hanging snare; and
3. Neck snare.
