SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

86.

(L) (1) THE PROVISIONS OF SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION ARE NOT APPLICABLE IN FREDERICK COUNTY. IN FREDERICK COUNTY, BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 2 A.M. AND 6 A.M. ON ANY DAY, A PERSON MAY NOT CONSUME ANY ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ON ANY PREMISES OPEN TO THE GENERAL PUBLIC, ANY PLACE OF PUBLIC ENTERTAINMENT, OR ANY PLACE AT WHICH SETUPS OR OTHER COMPONENT PARTS OF MIXED ALCOHOLIC DRINKS ARE SOLD UNDER ANY LICENSE ISSUED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF ARTICLE 56, AND ANY OWNER, OPERATOR, EMPLOYEE, OR MANAGER OF SAID PREMISES OR PLACES MAY NOT KNOWINGLY PERMIT SUCH CONSUMPTION.

(2) UNLESS OTHERWISE SPECIFICALLY PROVIDED, ANY PERSON VIOLATING THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBSECTION IS SUBJECT TO THE GENERAL PENALTY PROVISIONS PROVIDED FOR IN THIS SECTION.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1987.
