A police department may take any abandoned vehicle into custody. For this purpose, the police department may use its own personnel, equipment, and facilities or use other persons, equipment, and facilities for removing, preserving, and storing abandoned vehicles.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1987.
